## FROM THE PASTOR

#### Dear Salem Family,

One of my greatest joys as a pastor is having the opportunity to connect with people in the community. One of my favorite things to connect about is how to share God's love with our kids! So you can imagine how excited I was to have had the opportunity to gather together recently with representatives from both of our Blue Mt. Elementary Schools to talk about how Salem and our other downtown churches (St. Paul's Lutheran and St. John's UCC) can best support our students!

Did you know that the guidance counselor at Blue Mountain West attends our church? (*Hello Steve Freeman!*) At my request, Steve asked the teachers and nurse what they most needed right now.

I also spoke with the guidance counselor (Molly Zweibel) and the PTO president at the East building and from these conversations a Care Team was created to more fully address the needs of our students at this school.

From these conversations a few initial needs were highlighted. The common item requested at both schools is simply snacks to offer hungry students during the school day. It is often difficult for kids to focus on learning when their bellies are hungry. Simple nourishing prepackaged snacks are welcomed- think granola bars, peanut butter crackers, etc.

Beyond that we received a special request from each school:

- BMEW- Fleece Coats and Winter Coats
- BMEE- \$25 Gift Cards for Boyer's and Redner's to help families in need for Thanksgiving and who are struggling with food insecurity throughout the year.

So, in our November month of Celebration and Thanksgiving we will hold our first Thanksgiving Drive to Support our Students! We will collect items through November 13<sup>th</sup> and will deliver to the schools on November 14<sup>th</sup>. You can bring items to worship on Sunday or to the church office during the week.

This is just the beginning of an exciting partnership, with our downtown churches and our schools! Imagine all that God can do as we work together! If you are interested in working directly with me and our schools to continue to build these partnerships, I would love to have your support.


### COMMUNITY OUTREACH
