Pastor Shin Ae Speaks November 16 - "The Power of Corporate Gratitude" 2 Chronicles 20:21-22

Last week, we met King Jehoshaphat in 2 Chronicles 20:20–21. He was the king of the southern kingdom of Judah during the era when Israel was divided into North and South. In a moment of crisis— when the peoples of Moab, Ammon, and Edom joined forces across the Jordan to invade Judah— Jehoshaphat's response was astonishing.

Instead of devising a military strategy, purchasing new weapons, or seeking the aid of a stronger nation, he formed a **choir**.

One can almost hear the incredulous whispers:

"Are you out of your mind? What are you doing at a time like this?"

Yet Jehoshaphat placed the singers **in front of the army**, and they literally began to praise the Lord. At the very moment when fear, despair, and panic seemed most natural, praise rose instead.

All true praise begins with **remembering** what God has done. When we look back, we discover that every step was grace; gratitude flows from the memory of God's faithfulness. When we realize that the wilderness was the place where God taught us to rely on Him alone— where He delivered fresh manna every morning like a divine dawn delivery— praise wells up. The great mountain before me becomes a Jericho wall that will surely fall; the deep sea ahead becomes a Red Sea that will certainly part.

The song Jehoshaphat's choir sang was, remarkably, an ancient hymn written long before by King David:

"Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His love endures forever" (1 Chronicles 16:34; Psalms 106:1; 107:1; 118:1; 136:1). It was a well-known, beloved refrain of Israel's faith.

As the choir sang the very words of Scripture, the entire army must have joined them. And then something miraculous happened— God Himself set **ambushes** against their enemies and utterly defeated them.

This is the power of corporate praise and thanksgiving.

When a congregation, a family, a church— when even two or three gather in the name of Jesus and lift their voices together— the saving work of God moves in mighty ways. The same God who fought for Judah will move in our church and in our individual lives today.

Amen.
